Eastern Regional Law Review Consultation



The National Commission for Women organized a Regional Law Review Consultation on Rights of Muslim Women – Reviewing Muslim Personal Laws in collaboration with the Himachal Pradesh National Law University and its Centre for Child and Woman Studies. The deliberation was part of the ongoing series of Consultations that the Commission is organizing to incorporate viewpoints from diverse sectors and stakeholders from different regions in the process of suggesting comprehensive changes in the law.

Consultation on Rights of Muslim Women



The National Commission for Women conducted the Eastern Region Consultation on Law Review of 'Role of Muslim Women -Reviewing Muslim Personal Law' in collaboration with National University of Study and Research in Law, Ranchi on December 11, 2022 in order to review the existing law and its implementation in letter and spirit. The Commission will be organizing five Regional Consultations on the topic.

Seminar on Anti-Human Trafficking



The National Commission for Women organized a Seminar on ‘Awareness on Anti-Human Trafficking’ in collaboration with Maharashtra Police and Maharashtra State Commission for Women. Chairperson Ms Rekha Sharma shared her inaugural address with the participants. Officers and representatives of all 45 AHTUs of Maharashtra Police are participating in the seminar. Over 400 participants including NGOs, Civil Society Organizations and students are also attending the seminar.
