The National Commission for Women organised a seminar on Legal Awareness on NRI Marital Issues Faced by Women Survivors in collaboration with Women Safety Wing, Telangana Police and in support with Telangana State Commission for Women. The day-long seminar organised on December 17 was divided into 3 Technical Sessions on the topics; 'Socio-Cultural Context of NRI Marriages in Telangana', 'Role of Stakeholders- Issues related to Judicial Processes, Impounding of Passports, Child Custody, International Jurisdiction' and 'Police Procedure and other complexities involved in NRI Marriages'.

NCW launches online resource center to help women on issues pertaining to cyberbullying, cyberstalking, financial frauds

The National Commission for Women launched an online Resource Center on 9th December, 2021 to help women in distress on issues related to online safety such as cyber bullying, cyber stalking, financial frauds, etc. under the "We Think Digital" programme, run collaboratively by NCW, Meta and Cyber Peace Foundation.

The Centre will give provide information on cyber security in the form of posters, awareness videos, quizzes and self learning modules which will include lessons with tips for safe usage and reporting and redressal of cyber crimes. The Center will also provide information on all the avenues of reporting in case a woman faces any cyber crime with a step-by-step process of reporting on cyber-crime issues including reporting on social media platforms, getting content taken down from website, etc.

OFFICIAL VISIT TO ASSAM

The National Commission for Women led by Hon'ble Chairperson, NCW Ms. Rekha Sharma undertook an official visit to Assam. There have been various reports about the need for improvement in the working as well as living condition of women working in the tea gardens. The Commission being concerned about the welfare of these women visited the Tea gardens to assess the condition of these women.



RECOMMENDATIONS OF COMMISSION'S TEAM

(i) There is no ATM facility, there is a need to install ATM to enable them to operate /withdraw their money as per their requirement. This would result in effective implementation of digital transaction of wages and direct benefit transfer.

(ii) Training of alternative skills like dairy farming, poultry may also be taken up in association with Veterinary/Agriculture Universities and colleges in nearby districts.

(iii) Regarding transport, the management offered to share cost in case the Government Transport Department is willing to introduce public transport in the area.

(iv) There is need for associating some organization like Alcoholic Anonymous as alcohol is a menace in the garden leading to domestic violence and other crimes.



Chairperson, NCW held a meeting with Hon'ble Chief Minister of Assam, Shri Himanta Biswa Sarma at Assembly Secretariat, Guwahati. During the meeting, she briefed the Chief Minister about the observation and finding of NCW's visit in the tea gardens of Dibrugarh. Chairperson, NCW also made a courtesy call on the Hon'ble Governor of Assam.

Hon'ble Chairperson, NCW had a meeting with DGP and other senior Police Officers to discuss crimes against women in the state and pending complaints in NCW pertaining to Assam. During the meeting, the officers made a presentation on the various initiatives of Police to address the issues of women.



SHE IS A CHANGEMAKER



In order to improve leadership skills of grassroot women political leaders, the National Commission for Women launched a pan-India capacity building programme, 'She is a Changemaker' for women representatives at all levels starting from gram panchayats to Legislative Assemblies, women parliamentarians and political workers. The capacity building programme will be undertaken in association with region-wise training institutes to improve skills of women political leaders.



TRAINING PROGRAM

The first training programme in the 'She is a Changemaker' series was inaugurated in collaboration with Rhambhau Mhalgi Prabodhini, Thane, Maharashtra by Ms Rekha Sharma, Chairperson, NCW. The three-day capacity programme for women in Municipal Corporation was organised from December 7 to December 9.



TRAINING OF TRAINERS

The National Commission for Women collaborated with India Institute of Secretariat Training (ISTM) and conducted 5 Day physical training Trainers-Training Programme for Protection Officers and trained 46 trainers across the country. Chairperson, NCW interacted with the participants and addressed their queries. Trainers from 20 states participated in the Training of Trainers Programme for Capacity Building of Protection Officers organized by NCW.

The Commission has been conducting online training programmes for Protection Officers in collaboration with Lal Bahudar Shastri National Academy of Administration (LBSNAA).
